Drying tea leaves consumes a lot of energy. Vietnamese developer CCS uses biomass gasifiers to burn organic-based materials under conditions of insufficient oxygen supply. The biomass consists of locally available agricultural and forestry residues such as corn cobs, cassava stalks, sawdust, woodchips, chips, etc.
